A BILL

To allow for innovations and alternative technologies that
meet or exceed desired energy efficiency goals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Enabling Energy Sav-
5 ing Innovations Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. INNOVATIVE COMPONENT TECHNOLOGIES.**

7 Section 342(f) of the Energy Policy and Conservation
8 Act (42 U.S.C. 6313(f)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “paragraphs
2 (2) through (5)” and inserting “paragraphs (2)
3 through (6)”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following new
5 paragraph:

6 “(6) INNOVATIVE COMPONENT TECH-
7 NOLOGIES.—Subparagraph (C) of paragraph (1)
8 shall not apply to a walk-in cooler or walk-in freezer
9 component if the component manufacturer has dem-
10 onstrated to the satisfaction of the Secretary that
11 the component reduces energy consumption at least
12 as much as if such subparagraph were to apply. In
13 support of any demonstration under this paragraph,
14 a manufacturer shall provide to the Secretary all
15 data and technical information necessary to fully
16 evaluate its application.”.
