- 3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN MEN'S FOOTWEAR.
- 4 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.23.77 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 6 certain men's footwear with outer soles and uppers of rub-
- 7 bers or plastics) is amended—
- 8 (1) by striking "\$20/pair" and inserting "\$24/
- 9 pair"; and

- 1 (2) by striking the date in the effective period 2 column and inserting "12/31/2015".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 4 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
