1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MIXTURES OF CAPROLACTAM DISULFIDE WITH**
4 **AN ELASTOMER BINDER OF ETHYLENE-PRO-**
5 **PYLENE-DIENE MONOMER AND ETHYL VINYL**
6 **ACETATE, AND DISPERSING AGENTS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.12.74 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to

1 mixtures of caprolactam disulfide with an elastomer binder
2 of ethylene-propylene-diene monomer and ethyl vinyl ace-
3 tate, and dispersing agents) is amended by striking the
4 date in the effective period column and inserting “12/31/
5 2015”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
7 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
8 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
9 the date of the enactment of this Act.
