3 **SECTION 1. HAND TOOLS DESIGNED FOR SECURING PLAS-**

4 **TIC FASTENERS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Hand tools designed for securing plastic fasteners (provided for in sub-heading 8205.59.80)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
