Mr. HARPER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To redesignate the Noxubee National Wildlife Refuge as
the Sam D. Hamilton Noxubee National Wildlife Refuge.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION OF THE NOXUBEE NATIONAL**

4 **WILDLIFE REFUGE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Noxubee National Wildlife
6 Refuge, located in the State of Mississippi, is redesignated
7 as the “Sam D. Hamilton Noxubee National Wildlife Ref-
8 uge”.

9 (b) BOUNDARY REVISION.—Nothing in this Act pre-
10 vents the Secretary of the Interior from making adjust-

1 ments to the boundaries of the Sam D. Hamilton Noxubee
2 National Wildlife Refuge (referred to in this section as the
3 “Refuge”), as the Secretary determines to be appropriate,
4 to carry out the mission of the National Wildlife Refuge
5 System in accordance with the National Wildlife Refuge
6 System Administration Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. 668dd et
7 seq.) and any other applicable authority.

8 (c) ADDITION OF LAND.—Nothing in this Act pre-
9 vents the Secretary of the Interior from adding to the Ref-
10 uge new land or parcels of the National Wildlife Refuge
11 System, as the Secretary determines to be appropriate, to
12 carry out the mission of the National Wildlife Refuge Sys-
13 tem in accordance with the National Wildlife Refuge Sys-
14 tem Administration Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. 668dd et seq.)
15 and any other applicable authority.

16 (d) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any statute,
17 rule, regulation, executive order, publication, map, paper,
18 or other document of the United States to the Noxubee
19 National Wildlife Refuge is deemed to refer to the Sam
20 D. Hamilton Noxubee National Wildlife Refuge.
