# **A BILL**

To exempt from the Lacey Act Amendments of 1981 certain water transfers by the North Texas Municipal Water District and the Greater Texoma Utility Authority.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “North Texas Zebra  
5 Mussel Barrier Act of 2012”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMPLIANCE WITH LACEY ACT.**

7        The Lacey Act Amendments of 1981 (16 U.S.C.  
8 3371 et seq.) shall not apply with respect to any water  
9 transfer by the North Texas Municipal Water District and  
10 the Greater Texoma Utility Authority using only closed  
11 conveyance systems from the Lake Texoma raw water in-  
12 take structure to treatment facilities at which all zebra  
13 mussels are extirpated and removed from the water trans-  
14 ferred.
