## A BILL

To amend the Federal Crop Insurance Act to expand coverage under plans of insurance available under such Act to include losses to an insured commodity when, as a result of a federally-imposed quarantine, the commodity must be destroyed, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Containing Risk, Of-  
5 fering Protection Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. COVERAGE OF QUARANTINE LOSSES TO INSURED**  
2 **COMMODITIES UNDER THE FEDERAL CROP**  
3 **INSURANCE ACT.**

4 (a) **EXPANSION TO INCLUDE QUARANTINE**  
5 **LOSSES.**—Section 508(a)(1) of the Federal Crop Insur-  
6 ance Act (7 U.S.C. 1508(a)(1)) is amended in the second  
7 sentence—

8 (1) by striking “be due to drought” and insert-  
9 ing “be due—

10 “(A) to drought”;

11 (2) by striking “Secretary.” and inserting  
12 “Secretary); or”; and

13 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
14 paragraph:

15 “(B) to a quarantine imposed under Fed-  
16 eral law, pursuant to the terms of which the  
17 commodity is destroyed or otherwise unable to  
18 be marketed or otherwise utilized for its in-  
19 tended purpose (as determined by the Sec-  
20 retary).”.

21 (b) **APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT.**—Subparagraph  
22 (B) of section 508(a)(1) of the Federal Crop Insurance  
23 Act (7 U.S.C. 1508(a)(1)), as added by subsection (a)(3),  
24 shall apply beginning with the 2014 reinsurance year.
