- 6 FOR FORMER PRESIDENTS AND FOR THE
- 7 CHILDREN OF FORMER PRESIDENTS.
- 8 (a) Former Presidents.—Section 3056(a)(3) of
- 9 title 18, United States Code, is amended by striking "un-
- 10 less the former President did not" and all that follows
- 11 through "warrant such protection".
- 12 (b) CHILDREN OF FORMER PRESIDENTS.—Section
- 13 3056(a)(4) of title 18, United States Code, is amended
- 14 by striking "for a period" and all that follows through
- 15 "comes first".
