A BILL

For the relief of Allan Bolor Kelley.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR ALLAN**
4 **BOLOR KELLEY.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
7 Act, Allan Bolor Kelley shall be eligible for issuance of
8 an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that of
9 an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon
10 filing an application for issuance of an immigrant visa
11 under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status
12 to lawful permanent resident.

13 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Allan Bolor Kelley
14 enters the United States before the filing deadline speci-
15 fied in subsection (c), he shall be considered to have en-
16 tered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible,
17 be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245 of
18 the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of the
19 enactment of this Act.

20 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
21 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
22 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
23 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
24 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

1 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—

2 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
3 idence to Allan Bolor Kelley, the Secretary of State shall
4 instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the cur-
5 rent or next following fiscal year, the total number of im-
6 migrant visas that are made available to natives of the
7 country of the alien's birth under section 203(a) of the
8 Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the
9 total number of immigrant visas that are made available
10 to natives of the country of the alien's birth under section
11 202(e) of such Act.

12 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION
13 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural
14 parents, brothers, and sisters of Allan Bolor Kelley shall
15 not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right,
16 privilege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality
17 Act.
