- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ST. CROIX RIVER CROSSING PROJECT.
- 4 Notwithstanding section 7(a) of the Wild and Scenic
- 5 Rivers Act (16 U.S.C. 1278(a)), the head of any Federal
- 6 agency or department may authorize and assist in the con-
- 7 struction of a new extradosed bridge crossing the St. Croix
- 8 River approximately 6 miles north of the I-94 crossing, if
- 9 the mitigation items described in paragraph 9 of the 2006
- 10 St. Croix River Crossing Project Memorandum of Under-
- 11 standing for Implementation of Riverway Mitigation Items,
- 12 signed by the Federal Highway Administration on March
- 13 28, 2006, and by the National Park Service on March 27,
- 14 2006 (including any subsequent amendments to the Memo-
- 15 randum of Understanding), are included as enforceable con-
