

In the Senate of the United States,

March 15, 2012.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 886) entitled “An Act to require the Secretary of the Treasury to mint coins in commemoration of the 225th anniversary of the establishment of the Nation’s first Federal law enforcement agency, the United States Marshals Service.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

At the end, add the following:

1 **SEC. 8. FINANCIAL ASSURANCES.**

2 The Secretary shall take such actions as may be nec-
3 essary to ensure that—

4 (1) minting and issuing coins under this Act
5 will not result in any net cost to the United States
6 Government;

7 (2) no funds, including applicable surcharges,
8 shall be disbursed to any recipient designated in sec-
9 tion 7 until the total cost of designing and issuing

1 all of the coins authorized by this Act (including
2 labor, materials, dies, use of machinery, overhead ex-
3 penses, marketing, and shipping) is recovered by the
4 United States Treasury, consistent with sections
5 5112(m) and 5134(f) of title 31, United States
6 Code.
