RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require authorizing committees to hold annual hearings on GAO investigative reports on the identification, consolidation, and elimination of duplicative Government programs.

1 *Resolved*, That clause 2 of rule X of the Rules of the
2 House of Representatives is amended by adding at the end
3 the following new paragraph:

4 “(f) Within 90 calendar days after the Comptroller
5 General transmits each annual report to Congress identi-

1 fying programs, agencies, offices, and initiatives with du-
2 plicative goals and activities within the Government pursu-
3 ant to section 21 of the the joint resolution of February
4 12, 2010, increasing the statutory limit on the public debt
5 (Public Law 111–139), each standing committee (except
6 the Committee on Appropriations) with jurisdiction over
7 any such program or agency covered by that report shall
8 conduct hearings on the recommendations for consolida-
9 tion and elimination of such program or agency.”.

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
