## RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require that a Member, Delegate, or Resident Commissioner notify the Clerk of whether that Member, Delegate, or Resident Commissioner elects to participate in the Federal Employee Health Benefits Program.

- 1       *Resolved*, That rule XXVI of the Rules of the House
- 2 of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the
- 3 following new clause:
- 4       “4.(a) Not later than 60 days after taking the oath
- 5 of office or 15 days after the adoption of this clause, a
- 6 Member, Delegate, or Resident Commissioner shall notify
- 7 the Clerk of whether that Member, Delegate, or Resident

1 Commissioner elects to participate in the Federal Em-  
2 ployee Health Benefits Program. Not later than 15 days  
3 after changing any such election, that Member, Delegate,  
4 or Resident Commissioner shall so notify the Clerk.

5 “(b) The notifications made pursuant to paragraph  
6 (a) shall be made under the same terms as the financial  
7 disclosure statement required under this rule.”.
