## **RESOLUTION**

1	Resolved, That the House of Representatives—
2	(1) recognizes the historic significance of the
3	113th anniversary of the sovereign and independent
4	country of the Philippines on June 12, 1898;
5	(2) reaffirms the bonds of friendship and co-
6	operation which have existed between the United
7	States and the Philippines and commits to strength-
8	ening those bonds;

1	(3) commends the people of the Philippines for
2	enduring through struggle and hardship;
3	(4) reaffirms its support for the Philippines to
4	defend its internal security from terrorism;
5	(5) reaffirms its enduring support for the Phil-
6	ippines;
7	(6) supports increased public awareness of the
8	events surrounding the Philippine Declaration of
9	Independence, and the vibrant and beautiful culture
10	of the Philippines;
11	(7) recognizes the courage and bravery of the
12	Filipino and Filipino American servicemen and serv-
13	icewomen who have fought alongside and in the
14	United States Armed Forces; and
15	(8) supports the continuing development of the
16	Filipino American community as a integral part of
17	America's cultural fabric.
