Mr. BRALEY of Iowa submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6083) to provide for the reform and continuation of agricultural and other programs of the Department of Agriculture through fiscal year 2017, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution, the Speaker shall declare, pursuant to clause
3 2(b) of rule XVIII, the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 6083) to provide for the reform
6 and continuation of agricultural and other programs of the
7 Department of Agriculture through fiscal year 2017, and
8 for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be

1 dispensed with. All points of order against consideration
2 of the bill are waived. All points of order against provi-
3 sions in the bill are waived. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall
4 not apply to the consideration of the bill. General debate
5 shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed three
6 hours, to be equally divided and controlled by Mr. Braley
7 of Iowa and a Member opposed thereto. After general de-
8 bate, the bill shall be considered for amendment under the
9 five-minute rule. During consideration of the bill for
10 amendment, the chair of the Committee of the Whole may
11 accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the
12 Member offering an amendment has caused it to be print-
13 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated
14 for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments
15 so printed shall be considered as read. At the conclusion
16 of the consideration of the bill for amendment, the Com-
17 mittee shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
18 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
19 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
20 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
21 motion, except one motion to recommit with or without
22 instructions. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-
23 ports that it has come to no resolution on the bill, then,
24 on the next legislative day, the House shall, immediately
25 after the third daily order of business under clause 1 of

- 1 rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the Whole House
- 2 on the state of the Union for further consideration of the
- 3 bill.
