A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to finalize a proposed rule to amend the spill prevention, control, and countermeasure rule to tailor and streamline the requirements for the dairy industry, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the
5 date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the
6 Environmental Protection Agency shall finalize the pro-

1 posed rule entitled “Oil Pollution Prevention; Spill Preven-
2 tion, Control, and Countermeasure Rule Requirements—
3 Amendments” (74 Fed. Reg. 2461 (January 15, 2009))
4 to exempt certain milk containers and associated piping
5 and appurtenance from the Spill Prevention, Control, and
6 Countermeasure program.

7 (b) FORBEARANCE.—Until the effective date of the
8 rule finalized under subsection (a), the Administrator of
9 the Environmental Protection Agency may not take regu-
10 latory action against dairy and dairy product producers,
11 processors, handlers, and distributors under the oil pollu-
12 tion prevention regulation in part 112 of title 40, Code
13 of Federal Regulations, related to the exemptions in the
14 proposed rule described in subsection (a).
