A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to enter into a cooperative agreement for a park headquarters at San Antonio Missions National Historical Park, to expand the boundary of the Park, to conduct a study of potential land acquisitions, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “San Antonio Missions
3 National Historical Park Boundary Expansion Act of
4 2011”.

5 **SEC. 2. PARK HEADQUARTERS LEASE AND BOUNDARY**
6 **STUDY.**

7 Section 201 of Public Law 95–629 (16 U.S.C. 410ee)
8 is amended—

9 (1) by redesignating subsections (b), (c), (d),
10 (e), and (f) as subsections (c), (e), (f), (g), and (h)
11 respectively;

12 (2) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-
13 lowing new subsection:

14 “(b)(1) The Secretary shall conduct a study of lands
15 within Bexar and Wilson Counties, Texas, to identify
16 lands that would be suitable for inclusion within the
17 boundaries of the park. In conducting the study, the Sec-
18 retary shall examine the natural, cultural, recreational,
19 and scenic values and characteristics of lands within
20 Bexar and Wilson Counties.

21 “(2) Not later than 3 years after the date funds are
22 made available for the study under paragraph (1), the Sec-
23 retary shall submit to the Committee on Natural Re-
24 sources of the House of Representatives and the Com-
25 mittee on Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate

1 a report on the findings, conclusions, and recommenda-
 2 tions of the study.”; and

3 ~~(3)~~ by inserting after subsection (c) (as so re-
 4 designated) the following new subsection:

5 “(d)(1) The Secretary may enter into a cooperative
 6 agreement with the City of San Antonio or its designee,
 7 for operation of a facility outside the boundary of the park
 8 that would provide visitor facilities and office space for
 9 a headquarters and operational support for the park.

10 “(2) The Secretary may plan, design, construct, and
 11 install in the facilities described in the cooperative agree-
 12 ment exhibits related to the resources at the park.

13 “(3) The Secretary may assign park employees to
 14 provide interpretive services, including visitor information
 15 and education, at facilities outside the boundary of the
 16 park.”.

17 **SEC. 3. BOUNDARY EXPANSION.**

18 Section 201(a) of Public Law 95-629 (16 U.S.C.
 19 410ee(a)) is amended as follows:

20 (1) By striking “In order” and inserting the
 21 following: “(1) In order”.

22 (2) By striking “The park shall also” and in-
 23 serting the following:

24 “(2) The park shall also”.

1 (3) By striking “After advising the” and insert-
2 ing the following:

3 “~~(4) After advising the~~”.

4 (4) By inserting after paragraph (2) (as so des-
5 ignated by paragraph (2) above) the following:

6 “~~(3) The boundary of the park is further modified~~
7 to include approximately ~~151~~ acres, as depicted on the
8 map titled ‘San Antonio Missions National Historical
9 Park Proposed Boundary Addition 2009’, numbered ~~472/~~
10 ~~468,027~~, and dated November 2009. The map shall be on
11 file and available for inspection in the appropriate offices
12 of the National Park Service, U.S. Department of the In-
13 terior. The Secretary of the Interior may not use con-
14 demnation authority to acquire any lands or interests in
15 lands under this Act.”.

16 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

17 *This Act may be cited as the “San Antonio Missions*
18 *National Historical Park Boundary Expansion Act of*
19 *2011”.*

20 **SEC. 2. PARK BOUNDARY STUDY.**

21 *Section 201 of Public Law 95–629 (16 U.S.C. 410ee)*
22 *is amended—*

23 (1) *by redesignating subsections (b), (c), (d), (e),*
24 *and (f) as subsections (c), (e), (f), (g), and (h), respec-*
25 *tively;*

1 (2) *by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-*
2 *lowing:*

3 “(b) *STUDY.*—

4 “(1) *IN GENERAL.*—*The Secretary shall conduct*
5 *a study of land in Bexar and Wilson Counties, Texas,*
6 *to identify land that would be suitable for inclusion*
7 *in the park.*

8 “(2) *REQUIREMENTS.*—*In conducting the study*
9 *under paragraph (1), the Secretary shall examine the*
10 *natural, cultural, recreational, and scenic values and*
11 *characteristics of the land.*

12 “(3) *REPORT.*—*Not later than 3 years after the*
13 *date on which funds are made available for the study*
14 *under paragraph (1), the Secretary shall submit to*
15 *the Committee on Natural Resources of the House of*
16 *Representatives and the Committee on Energy and*
17 *Natural Resources of the Senate a report that de-*
18 *scribes the findings, conclusions, and recommenda-*
19 *tions of the study.”;*

20 (3) *by inserting after subsection (c) (as redesign-*
21 *ated by paragraph (1)) the following:*

22 “(d) *INTERPETIVE SERVICES.*—*The Secretary may as-*
23 *sign park employees to provide interpretive services, includ-*
24 *ing visitor information and education, at facilities outside*
25 *the boundary of the park.”; and*

1 (4) in paragraph (1)(D) of subsection (g) (as re-
 2 designated by paragraph (1)), by striking “subsection
 3 (b)(2)” and inserting “subsection (c)(2)”.

4 **SEC. 3. BOUNDARY EXPANSION.**

5 Section 201 of Public Law 95–629 (16 U.S.C. 410ee)
 6 is amended—

7 (1) by striking “**SEC. 201. (A)** In order” and in-
 8 sert the following:

9 **“SEC. 201. SAN ANTONIO MISSIONS HISTORICAL PARK.**

10 “(a) *ESTABLISHMENT.*—

11 “(1) *IN GENERAL.*—In order”; and

12 (2) in subsection (a)—

13 (A) in the second sentence, by striking “The
 14 park shall also” and inserting the following:

15 “(2) *ADDITIONAL LAND.*—The park shall also”;

16 (B) in the third sentence, by striking “After
 17 advising the” and inserting the following:

18 “(4) *REVISIONS.*—After advising the”; and

19 (C) by inserting after paragraph (2) (as
 20 designated by subparagraph (A)) the following:

21 “(3) *BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.*—

22 “(A) *IN GENERAL.*—The boundary of the
 23 park is modified to include approximately 151
 24 acres, as depicted on the map entitled ‘San Anto-
 25 nio Missions National Historical Park Proposed

1 *Boundary Addition*’, numbered 472-68, 027, and
2 dated November 2009.

3 “(B) *AVAILABILITY OF MAP.*—*The map de-*
4 *scribed in subparagraph (A) shall be on file and*
5 *available for inspection in the appropriate offices*
6 *of the National Park Service.*

7 “(C) *ACQUISITION OF LAND.*—*The Secretary*
8 *of the Interior may acquire the land or any in-*
9 *terest in the land described in in subparagraph*
10 *(A) by purchase from willing sellers, donation,*
11 *or exchange.”.*
