## A BILL

To suspend sales of petroleum products from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve until certain conditions are met.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Strategic Petroleum  
5 Supplies Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON SALES FROM THE STRATEGIC PE-**  
7 **TROLEUM RESERVE.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection  
9 (b), the Administration shall not authorize a sale of petro-  
10 leum products from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve es-

1 tablished under part B of title I of the Energy Policy and  
2 Conservation Act (42 U.S.C. 6231 et seq.) until the date  
3 on which all permits necessary under Executive Order  
4 13337 (3 U.S.C. 301 note; relating to issuance of permits  
5 with respect to certain energy-related facilities and land  
6 transportation crossings on the international boundaries  
7 of the United States) for the Keystone XL pipeline project  
8 application filed on September 19, 2008 (including amend-  
9 ments) have been issued.

10 (b) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a) shall not affect any  
11 obligations of the United States under the international  
12 energy program.
