3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF THE DRUG-FREE COMMUNITIES**
4 **SUPPORT PROGRAM THROUGH FISCAL YEAR**
5 **2017.**

6 Section 1024(a) of the National Narcotics Leadership
7 Act of 1988 (21 U.S.C. 1524(a)) is amended by striking
8 paragraph (9) and all that follows and inserting the fol-
9 lowing:

10 “(9) \$90,000,000 for fiscal year 2006;

- 1 “(10) \$99,000,000 for fiscal year 2007;
- 2 “(11) \$109,000,000 for fiscal year 2008;
- 3 “(12) \$114,000,000 for fiscal year 2009;
- 4 “(13) \$119,000,000 for fiscal year 2010;
- 5 “(14) \$124,000,000 for fiscal year 2011;
- 6 “(15) \$129,000,000 for fiscal year 2012;
- 7 “(16) \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2013;
- 8 “(17) \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2014;
- 9 “(18) \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2015;
- 10 “(19) \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2016; and
- 11 “(20) \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2017.”.
