## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on camel hair, carded or combed.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CAMEL HAIR, CARDED OR COMBED.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.12.22 of the Har-  
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6 camel hair, carded or combed) is amended by striking the  
7 date in the effective period column and inserting “12/31/  
8 2015”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
10 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
