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**A BILL**

To deem the submission of certain claims to an Indian Health Service contracting officer as timely.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TIMELY SUBMISSION OF CERTAIN CLAIMS.**

4       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a claim  
5       submitted to an Indian Health Service contracting officer  
6       pursuant to the Indian Self-Determination and Education  
7       Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 450 et seq.) on or before Octo-

ber 31, 2005, involving a claim that accrued after October  
1, 1995, and on or before September 30, 1999, shall be  
deemed to be timely submitted.



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
