A BILL

To designate the United States courthouse located at 2601 2nd Avenue North, Billings, Montana, as the “James F. Battin United States Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. JAMES F. BATTIN UNITED STATES COURT-**

4 **HOUSE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—

1 (1) DESIGNATION.—The United States court-
2 house located at 2601 2nd Avenue North, Billings,
3 Montana, shall be known and designated as the
4 “James F. Battin United States Courthouse”.

5 (2) TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.—The “James F.
6 Battin United States Courthouse” located at 315
7 North 26th Street, Billings, Montana, shall no
8 longer be known and designated as the “James F.
9 Battin United States Courthouse”.

10 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
11 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
12 States to the United States courthouse referred to in sub-
13 section (a)(1) shall be deemed to be a reference to the
14 “James F. Battin United States Courthouse”.

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
