A BILL

To amend the Food and Nutrition Act to prohibit the provision of funds made available to carry out that Act in any State that allows income deductions for controlled substances, including medical marijuana.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON ASSISTANCE IN STATES AL-**
4 **LOWING INCOME DEDUCTIONS FOR CON-**
5 **TROLLED SUBSTANCES.**

6 Section 5 of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7
7 U.S.C. 2014) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
8 lowing:

1 “(o) PROHIBITION ON ASSISTANCE IN STATES AL-
2 LOWING INCOME DEDUCTIONS FOR CONTROLLED SUB-
3 STANCES.—None of the funds made available to carry out
4 this Act may be provided to households in any State that
5 allows income deductions for controlled substances prohib-
6 ited by Federal law as specified by schedule I of section
7 202(c) of the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C.
8 812(c)), including medical marijuana.”.
