To amend the Animal Welfare Act to modify the definition
of “exhibitor”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ANIMAL WELFARE.**

4 Section 2(h) of the Animal Welfare Act (7 U.S.C.
5 2132(h)) is amended by adding “an owner of a common,
6 domesticated household pet who derives less than a sub-
7 stantial portion of income from a nonprimary source (as
8 determined by the Secretary) for exhibiting an animal that
9 exclusively resides at the residence of the pet owner,” after
10 “stores,”.
