## A BILL

To amend the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 to preserve certain rates for the milk income loss contract program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “MILC Preservation  
5 Act of 2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. MILK INCOME LOSS CONTRACT PROGRAM.**

7 (a) PAYMENT RATE.—Section 1506(c)(3) of the  
8 Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C.  
9 8773(c)(3)) is amended—

1           (1) in subparagraph (A), by inserting “and” at  
2           the end; and

3           (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking “ending  
4           August 31, 2012” and all that follows through the  
5           end of subparagraph (C) and inserting “thereafter,  
6           45 percent.”

7           (b) PAYMENT RATE ADJUSTMENT FOR FEED  
8           PRICES.—Section 1506(d) of the Food, Conservation, and  
9           Energy Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 8773(d)) is amended—

10           (1) in paragraph (1), by striking the paragraph  
11           heading and all that follows through “August 31,  
12           2012,” and inserting the following:

13           “(1) IN GENERAL.—For any month beginning  
14           on or after January 1, 2008,”;

15           (2) by striking paragraph (2); and

16           (3) by redesignating paragraph (3) as para-  
17           graph (2).

18           (c) BUDGETARY EFFECTS.—The budgetary effects of  
19           this Act, for the purpose of complying with the Statutory  
20           Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010, shall be determined by ref-  
21           erence to the latest statement titled “Budgetary Effects  
22           of PAYGO Legislation” for this Act, submitted for print-  
23           ing in the Congressional Record by the Chairman of the

- 1 Senate Budget Committee, provided that such statement
- 2 has been submitted prior to the vote on passage.
