## A BILL

To authorize the United States Marshals Service to issue administrative subpoenas in investigations relating to unregistered sex offenders.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Finding Fugitive Sex  
5 Offenders Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUBPOENA AUTHORITY FOR THE UNITED STATES**  
2 **MARSHALS SERVICE.**

3 Section 566(e)(1) of title 28, United States Code, is  
4 amended—

5 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “and” at  
6 the end;

7 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking the period  
8 at the end and inserting “; and”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(C) issue administrative subpoenas in ac-  
11 cordance with section 3486 of title 18 solely for  
12 the purpose of investigating unregistered sex of-  
13 fenders (as that term is defined in section 3486  
14 of title 18).”.

15 **SEC. 3. CONFORMING AMENDMENT TO ADMINISTRATIVE**  
16 **SUBPOENA STATUTE.**

17 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 3486(a)(1) of title 18,  
18 United States Code, is amended—

19 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

20 (A) in clause (i)(II), by striking “or” at  
21 the end;

22 (B) by redesignating clause (ii) as clause  
23 (iii); and

24 (C) by inserting after clause (i) the fol-  
25 lowing:

1           “(ii) an unregistered sex offender conducted by  
2           the United States Marshals Service, the Director of  
3           the United States Marshals Service; or”]; and

4           (2) by striking subparagraph (D) and inserting  
5           the following:

6                   “(D) As used in this paragraph—

7                           “(i) the term ‘Federal offense involv-  
8                           ing the sexual exploitation or abuse of chil-  
9                           dren’ means an offense under section  
10                           1201, 1591, 2241(c), 2242, 2243, 2251,  
11                           2251A, 2252, 2252A, 2260, 2421, 2422,  
12                           or 2423, in which the victim is an indi-  
13                           vidual who has not attained the age of 18  
14                           years; and

15                           “(ii) the term ‘sex offender’ means an  
16                           individual required to register under the  
17                           Sex Offender Registration and Notification  
18                           Act (42 U.S.C. 16901 et seq.).”.

19           (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—  
20           Section 3486(a) of title 18, United States Code, is amend-  
21           ed—

22                   (1) in paragraph (6)(A), by striking “United  
23                   State” and inserting “United States”;

24                   (2) in paragraph (9), by striking “or (1)(A)(ii)”  
25                   and inserting “or (1)(A)(iii)”; and

- 1 (3) in paragraph (10), by striking “paragraph
- 2 (1)(A)(ii)” and inserting “paragraph (1)(A)(iii)”.
