Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and an adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives 2 *concurring*), That when the Senate recesses or adjourns 3 on any day from Thursday, March 29, 2012, through Sun-4 day, April 1, 2012, on a motion offered pursuant to this 5 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until 12:00 noon on 6 7 Monday, April 16, 2012, or such other time on that day 8 as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee 9 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent 10

resolution, whichever occurs first; and that when the 1 2 House adjourns on any legislative day through Friday, 3 April 13, 2012, on a motion offered pursuant to this con-4 current resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, 5 it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Monday, April 16, 6 2012, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to sec-7 tion 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first. 8 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the 9 Speaker of the House, or their respective designees, acting

10 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
11 Senate and the Minority Leader of the House, shall notify
12 the Members of the Senate and House, respectively, to re13 assemble at such place and time as they may designate
14 if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
