Mr. REID (for himself and Mr. McCONNELL) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and an adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 on any day from Friday, June 29, 2012, through Monday,
4 July 2, 2012, on a motion offered pursuant to this concur-
5 rent resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it
6 stand recessed or adjourned until 12:00 noon on Monday,
7 July 9, 2012, or such other time on that day as may be
8 specified by its Majority Leader or his designee in the mo-
9 tion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any re-
10 assembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-

1 tion, whichever occurs first; and that when the House ad-
2 journs on any legislative day from Friday, June 29, 2012,
3 through Friday, July 6, 2012, on a motion offered pursu-
4 ant to this concurrent resolution by its majority leader or
5 his designee, it stand adjourned until 2:00 p.m. on Mon-
6 day, July 9, 2012, or until time of any reassembly pursu-
7 ant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
8 occurs first.

9 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
10 Speaker of the House, or their respective designees, acting
11 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
12 Senate and the Minority Leader of the House, shall notify
13 the Members of the Senate and House, respectively, to re-
14 assemble at such place and time as they may designate
15 if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.

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
