CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for the
lying in state of the remains of the late Honorable Daniel
K. Inouye.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That in recognition of the long and distin-
3 guished service rendered to the Nation by Daniel K.
4 Inouye, a Senator from the State of Hawaii and formerly
5 a Representative from that State, his remains be per-
6 mitted to lie in state in the rotunda of the Capitol on De-
7 cember 20, 2012, and the Architect of the Capitol, under
8 the direction of the Speaker of the House of Representa-
9 tives and the President pro tempore of the Senate, shall

- 1 take all necessary steps for the accomplishment of that
- 2 purpose.
