CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF THE CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR NA-**
4 **TIONAL PEACE OFFICERS' MEMORIAL SERV-**
5 **ICE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Grand Lodge of the Fra-
7 ternal Order of Police and its auxiliary (in this resolution

1 referred to as the “sponsor”) shall be permitted to sponsor
 2 a public event, the 32nd Annual National Peace Officers’
 3 Memorial Service (in this resolution referred to as the
 4 “event”), on the Capitol Grounds, in order to honor the
 5 law enforcement officers who died in the line of duty dur-
 6 ing 2012.

7 (b) DATE OF EVENT.—The event shall be held on
 8 May 15, 2013, or on such other date as the Speaker of
 9 the House of Representatives and the Committee on Rules
 10 and Administration of the Senate jointly designate.

11 **SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

12 (a) IN GENERAL.—Under conditions to be prescribed
 13 by the Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
 14 Board, the event shall be—

15 (1) free of admission charge and open to the
 16 public; and

17 (2) arranged not to interfere with the needs of
 18 Congress.

19 (b) EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.—The sponsor shall
 20 assume full responsibility for all expenses and liabilities
 21 incident to all activities associated with the event.

22 **SEC. 3. EVENT PREPARATIONS.**

23 Subject to the approval of the Architect of the Cap-
 24 itol, the sponsor is authorized to erect upon the Capitol
 25 Grounds such stage, sound amplification devices, and

1 other related structures and equipment, as may be re-
2 quired for the event.

3 **SEC. 4. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

4 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
5 ment of the restrictions contained in section 5104(c) of
6 title 40, United States Code, concerning sales, advertise-
7 ments, displays, and solicitations on the Capitol Grounds,
8 as well as other restrictions applicable to the Capitol
9 Grounds, in connection with the event.
