## A BILL

To authorize appropriations for the SelectUSA Initiative, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “SelectUSA Authoriza-  
5        tion Act of 2013”.

6        **SEC. 2. SELECTUSA INITIATIVE DEFINED.**

7        In this Act, the term “SelectUSA Initiative” means  
8        the SelectUSA Initiative established by Executive Order  
9        13577 of June 15, 2011.

1 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE**  
2 **SELECTUSA INITIATIVE.**

3 There is authorized to be appropriated for the  
4 SelectUSA Initiative \$17,000,000 for each of fiscal years  
5 2014 through 2018.

6 **SEC. 4. REPORTS AND NOTIFICATIONS TO CONGRESS.**

7 The Secretary of Commerce shall, not later than De-  
8 cember 31 of 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, and 2018, submit  
9 to Congress a report on the activities of the SelectUSA  
10 Initiative during the preceding fiscal year. Each such re-  
11 port shall include the following:

12 (1) The grantees and projects to which assist-  
13 ance was provided under the SelectUSA Initiative  
14 during the preceding fiscal year, and the amount  
15 and type of assistance provided to each such grantee  
16 and project.

17 (2) The number of foreign firms that relocated  
18 to the United States during the preceding fiscal year  
19 as a result of the activities of the SelectUSA Initia-  
20 tive.

21 (3) Any findings that are made by the  
22 SelectUSA Initiative in conducting its activities and  
23 are relevant to promoting the United States as a  
24 destination for the location of manufacturing.
