## A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Honoring Ezeagwula  
3 and Long Act” or the “HEAL Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF LITTLE ROCK RECRUITING STA-**  
5 **TION ATTACK AS AN INTERNATIONAL TER-**  
6 **RORIST ATTACK FOR PURPOSES OF AWARD-**  
7 **ING THE PURPLE HEART.**

8 The attack that occurred at a recruiting station in  
9 Little Rock, Arkansas, on June 1, 2009, in which Private  
10 William Long of the United States Army was killed and  
11 Private Quinton Ezeagwula of the United States Army  
12 was wounded, was an international terrorist attack carried  
13 out by an enemy of the United States, and pursuant to  
14 Army Regulations regarding the award of the Purple  
15 Heart (AR 600–8–22, chapter 2, section II, 2–8b), Pri-  
16 vates Long and Ezeagwula are entitled to be awarded the  
17 Purple Heart.
