To amend the indemnification responsibilities applicable to the Secretary of Defense when Department of Defense property at military installations closed pursuant to a base closure law is conveyed to expand such indemnification responsibilities to include all military installations closed since October 24, 1988.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Base Redevelopment
5 and Indemnification Correction Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INDEMNIFICATION OF TRANSFEREES OF PROPERTY**
2 **AT ANY CLOSED MILITARY INSTALLATION.**

3 Section 330 of the National Defense Authorization
4 Act for Fiscal Year 1993 (Public Law 102–484; 10 U.S.C.
5 2687 note) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by striking “pursuant
7 to a base closure law” and inserting “after October
8 24, 1988, the date of the enactment of the Defense
9 Authorization Amendments and Base Closure and
10 Realignment Act (Public Law 100–526; 10 U.S.C.
11 2687 note)”; and

12 (2) in subsection (f), by striking paragraph (3).

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
