A BILL

To repeal the fossil fuel consumption percentage reduction requirements for Federal buildings under the Energy Conservation and Production Act.

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF FOSSIL FUEL CONSUMPTION PER-**
4 **CENTAGE REDUCTION REQUIREMENTS FOR**
5 **FEDERAL BUILDINGS.**

6 (a) REPEAL.—Subclauses (I) and (II) of section
7 305(a)(3)(D)(i) of the Energy Conservation and Produc-
8 tion Act (42 U.S.C. 6834(a)(3)(D)(i)) are repealed.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
2 305(a)(3)(D)(vi) of the Energy Conservation and Produc-
3 tion Act is amended by striking “subclauses (I) and (III)
4 of clause (i)” and inserting “clause (i)”.
