1 **SECTION 1. NAME OF THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-**
2 **FAIRS AND DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE JOINT**
3 **OUTPATIENT CLINIC, MARINA, CALIFORNIA.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Department of Veterans Af-
5 fairs and Department of Defense joint outpatient clinic
6 to be constructed at the intersection of the proposed Ninth
7 Street and the proposed First Avenue in Marina, Cali-
8 fornia, shall be known and designated as the “General
9 William H. Gourley Federal Outpatient Clinic: A Joint
10 VA–DOD Health Care Facility”.

11 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, regula-
12 tion, map, document, record, or other paper of the United
13 States to the Department of Veterans Affairs and Depart-
14 ment of Defense joint outpatient clinic referred to in sub-
15 section (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Gen-
16 eral William H. Gourley Federal Outpatient Clinic: A
17 Joint VA–DOD Health Care Facility”.

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
