A BILL

To ensure that any new or revised requirement providing for the screening, testing, or treatment of individuals operating commercial motor vehicles for sleep disorders is adopted pursuant to a rulemaking proceeding, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR RE-**
4 **QUIREMENTS RELATING TO SLEEP DIS-**
5 **ORDERS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Transportation
7 may implement or enforce a requirement providing for the
8 screening, testing, or treatment (including consideration
9 of all possible treatment alternatives) of individuals oper-
10 ating commercial motor vehicles for sleep disorders only
11 if the requirement is adopted pursuant to a rulemaking
12 proceeding.

13 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall not apply
14 to a requirement that was in force before September 1,
15 2013.

16 (c) SLEEP DISORDERS DEFINED.—In this section,
17 the term “sleep disorders” includes obstructive sleep
18 apnea.

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
