To allow for the harvest of gull eggs by the Huna Tlingit people within Glacier Bay National Park in the State of Alaska.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Huna Tlingit Tradi-
- 3 tional Gull Egg Use Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. LIMITED AUTHORIZATION FOR COLLECTION OF
- 5 GULL EGGS.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior (re-
- 7 ferred to in this Act as the "Secretary" may allow the
- 8 collection by members of the Hoonah Indian Association
- 9 of the eggs of glaucous-winged gulls (Laurus glaucescens)
- 10 within Glacier Bay National Park (referred to in this Act
- 11 as the "Park") not more frequently than twice each cal-
- 12 endar year at up to 5 locations within the Park, subject
- 13 to any terms and conditions that the Secretary determines
- 14 to be necessary.
- 15 (b) APPLICABLE LAW.—For the purposes of sections
- 16 203 and 816 of the Alaska National Interest Lands Con-
- 17 servation Act (16 U.S.C. 410hh-2, 3126), the collection
- 18 of eggs of glaucous-winged gulls within the Park in ac-
- 19 cordance with subsection (a) shall be considered to be a
- 20 use specifically permitted by that Act.
- 21 (c) Harvest Plan.—The Secretary shall establish
- 22 schedules, locations, and any additional terms and condi-
- 23 tions that the Secretary determines to be necessary for
- 24 the harvesting of eggs of glaucous-winged gulls in the

- 1 Park, based on an annual harvest plan to be prepared by
- $2\;$ the Secretary and the Hoonah Indian Association.
