A BILL

Making appropriations for fiscal year 2014 to ensure that members of the Armed Forces, including reserve components thereof, continue to receive pay and allowances for active service performed during a Government shutdown.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO**
2 **PROVIDE PAY AND ALLOWANCES FOR MEM-**
3 **BERS OF THE ARMED FORCES DURING GOV-**
4 **ERNMENT SHUTDOWN.**

5 (a) **APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR MILITARY PAY**
6 **AND ALLOWANCES.**—If a funding gap occurs during fiscal
7 year 2014 impacting the Armed Forces, amounts are here-
8 by appropriated, out of any money in the Treasury not
9 otherwise appropriated, at a rate for operations as pro-
10 vided for military personnel accounts by the Department
11 of Defense Appropriations Act, 2013 (division C of Public
12 Law 113–6), for the purpose of providing pay and allow-
13 ances (without interruption) to members of the Army,
14 Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard, includ-
15 ing reserve components thereof, who perform active service
16 during the funding gap.

17 (b) **FUNDING GAP DEFINED.**—In this section, the
18 term “funding gap” means any period of time after Sep-
19 tember 30, 2013, for which interim or full-year appropria-
20 tions for the military personnel accounts of the Armed
21 Forces for fiscal year 2014 have not been enacted by a
22 law other than this Act.

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
