## A BILL

To amend the National Historic Preservation Act to direct the Secretary of the Interior to provide technical or financial assistance to Hispanic-serving institutions for the establishment of historic preservation training and degree programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Preservation Research  
5 at Institutions Serving Minorities Act” or “PRISM Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. HISTORIC PRESERVATION TRAINING AND DEGREE**  
2 **PROGRAMS FOR HISPANIC-SERVING INSTITU-**  
3 **TIONS.**

4 Subparagraph (C) of section 101(j)(2) of the Na-  
5 tional Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470a(j)(2)) is  
6 amended—

7 (1) by striking “and” after “tribal colleges,”;

8 and

9 (2) by inserting after “Hawaiians,” the fol-  
10 lowing: “and to Hispanic-serving institutions as de-  
11 fined in section 502(a)(5) of the Higher Education  
12 Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1101a(a)(5)),”.
