3 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF PROPERTIES IN SOUTH CAROLINA**
4 **FROM JOHN H. CHAFEE COASTAL BARRIER**
5 **RESOURCES SYSTEM.**

6 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*The map subtitled “Long Pond*
7 *Unit SC–01” included in the sets of maps entitled “Coastal*
8 *Barrier Resources System” referred to in section 4(a) of the*
9 *Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)) and re-*
10 *lating to the Long Pond Unit in South Carolina is hereby*
11 *replaced by another map relating to the same unit entitled*
12 *“John H. Chafee Coastal Barrier Resources System Cor-*
13 *rected Long Pond Unit SC–01” dated September 30, 2014.*

14 (b) *AVAILABILITY.*—*The Secretary of the Interior shall*
15 *keep each map revised under subsection (a) on file and*
16 *available for inspection in accordance with section 4(b) of*
17 *the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(b)).*
