A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide an extension of the work opportunity tax credit for certain targeted groups.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF WORK OPPORTUNITY TAX**
4 **CREDIT FOR CERTAIN TARGETED GROUPS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section
6 51(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended
7 by inserting “(December 31, 2018, in the case of any
8 member of a targeted group described in subparagraph
9 (C), (E), (F), or (G) of subsection (d)(1))” before the pe-
10 riod at the end.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section shall apply to individuals who begin work for
3 the employer after December 31, 2013.

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
