To amend the District of Columbia Home Rule Act to clarify the rules regarding the determination of the compensation of the Chief Financial Officer of the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF DETERMINATION OF COM-**
4 **PENSATION OF CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER**
5 **OF DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.**

6 (a) DETERMINATION OF COMPENSATION.—Section
7 424(b)(2)(E) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act

1 (sec. 1–204.24(b)(2)(E), D.C. Official Code) is amended
2 to read as follows:

3 “(E) PAY.—The Chief Financial Officer
4 shall be paid at a rate such that the total
5 amount of compensation paid during any cal-
6 endar year does not exceed an amount equal to
7 the limit on total pay which is applicable during
8 the year under section 5307 of title 5, United
9 States Code, to an employee described in sec-
10 tion 5307(d) of such title.”.

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
12 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to pay periods be-
13 ginning on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
