3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Tobacco Smug-
5 gling in the Territories Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. TERRITORIES AND POSSESSIONS OF THE UNITED**
2 **STATES INCLUDED IN THE DEFINITION OF**
3 **STATE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE PROHIBI-**
4 **TION AGAINST TRAFFICKING IN CONTRA-**
5 **BAND CIGARETTES AND SMOKELESS TO-**
6 **BACCO.**

7 Paragraph (4) of section 2341 of title 18, United
8 States Code, is amended by striking “or the Virgin Is-
9 lands” and inserting “the Virgin Islands, American
10 Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Is-
11 lands, or Guam”.
