# **AN ACT**

To require the Attorney General to report on State law penalties for certain child abusers, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Kilah Davenport Child3 Protection Act of 2013".

#### 4 SEC. 2. ATTORNEY GENERAL REPORT.

5 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment of this Act, and again 3 years thereafter, the Attorney 6 7 General shall publish and submit to the Committee on the 8 Judiciary of the House of Representatives and the Com-9 mittee on the Judiciary of the United States Senate a report on the penalties for violations of laws prohibiting 10 11 child abuse in each of the 50 States, the District of Columbia, and each territory of the United States, including 12 13 whether the laws of that State, District, or territory provides for enhanced penalties when the victim has suffered 14 serious bodily injury, or permanent or protracted loss or 15 16 impairment of any mental or emotional function.
