A BILL

To redesignate the lock and dam located in Modoc, Illinois, commonly known as the Kaskaskia Lock and Dam, as the “Jerry F. Costello Lock and Dam”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The lock and dam located in Modoc, Illinois, author-
5 ized by the Act entitled “An Act authorizing the construc-
6 tion, repair, and preservation of certain public works on

1 rivers and harbors, and for other purposes”, approved
2 July 3, 1930 (46 Stat. 927), and commonly known as the
3 Kaskaskia Lock and Dam, is redesignated as the “Jerry
4 F. Costello Lock and Dam”.

5 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

6 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
7 paper, or other record of the United States to the lock
8 and dam referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
9 a reference to the “Jerry F. Costello Lock and Dam”.
