A BILL

To amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to prohibition on payment of bonuses and pay increases for executives of a State Exchange funded through Federal grants, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON PAYMENT OF BONUSES AND**
4 **PAY INCREASES FOR EXCHANGE EXECU-**
5 **TIVES.**

6 Section 1311(a) of the Patient Protection and Af-
7 fordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18031(a)) is amended by
8 adding at the end the following new paragraph:

1 “(6) PROHIBITION ON PAYMENT OF BONUSES
2 AND PAY INCREASES FOR EXCHANGE EXECU-
3 TIVES.—The Secretary shall provide that no funds
4 under a grant under this section may be used for a
5 bonus or pay increase (beyond the level of compensa-
6 tion in effect as of October 1, 2013) for a chief execu-
7 tive officer, chief information officer, chief oper-
8 ating officer, or similar executive with respect to the
9 operation of an Exchange on or after October 1,
10 2013.”.
