A BILL

To repeal the Biggert-Waters Flood Insurance Reform Act
of 2012.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF BIGGERT-WATERS FLOOD INSUR-**
4 **ANCE REFORM ACT OF 2012.**

5 Effective as of the enactment of the Biggert-Waters
6 Flood Insurance Reform Act of 2012 (title II of division
7 F of Public Law 112–141; 126 Stat. 916), such Act (other
8 than section 100203 (126 Stat. 916)) is repealed, and the
9 provisions of law amended or repealed by such Act (other

1 than by such section 100203) are restored or revived as
2 if such Act had not been enacted.

3 **SEC. 2. BUDGETARY EFFECTS OF THIS ACT.**

4 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
5 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
6 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
7 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this
8 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
9 by the Chairman of the Committee on the Budget of the
10 House of Representatives, as long as such statement has
11 been submitted prior to the vote on passage of this Act.
