Mr. GRAVES of Missouri (for himself and Mr. TERRY) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to designate natural gas fueling corridors in the United States for long haul truck traffic, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF NATURAL GAS FUELING COR-**
4 **RIDORS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Transportation,
6 in consultation with the Secretary of Energy and affected
7 States, shall designate natural gas fueling corridors in the
8 United States for long haul truck traffic.

1 (b) DESIGNATION PROCESS.—In designating natural
2 gas fueling corridors under subsection (a), the Secretary
3 shall—

4 (1) seek to establish an interconnection of nat-
5 ural gas fueling stations across the United States
6 that will serve the highest possible volume of long
7 haul truck traffic;

8 (2) take into consideration the location of exist-
9 ing natural gas fueling stations, with the goal of
10 having natural gas fueling stations located not
11 greater than 200 miles apart in such corridors; and

12 (3) provide public notice and an opportunity for
13 comment.

14 (c) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 1 year
15 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall
16 submit to Congress a report containing a description of
17 the natural gas fueling corridors designated under sub-
18 section (a), together with an explanation for the selection
19 of the corridors.
