Mr. WESTMORELAND introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To sunset funding under sections 1341 and 1342, and to repeal section 1343, of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Obamacare’s
5 Risky Provisions Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUNSETTING FUNDING UNDER SECTIONS 1341 AND**
2 **1342, AND REPEALING SECTION 1343, OF**
3 **PPACA.**

4 (a) SUNSETTING SECTION 1341.—Notwithstanding
5 any other provision of law—

6 (1) no payments may be required of health in-
7 surance issuers and third-party administrators under
8 section 1341 of the Patient Protection and Afford-
9 able Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18061) for any period
10 after December 31, 2014; and

11 (2) payments shall be made to health insurance
12 issuers under such section only to the extent of
13 available funds, as limited under paragraph (1).

14 (b) SUNSETTING SECTION 1342.—Notwithstanding
15 any other provision of law, the risk corridor program
16 under section 1342 of the Patient Protection and Afford-
17 able Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18062) shall only apply for 2014
18 and shall not apply for 2015 or 2016.

19 (c) REPEALING SECTION 1343.—Section 1343 of the
20 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C.
21 18063) is repealed, effective for years after 2014.

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
