3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Unmuzzle the Drug
5 Czar Act of 2014”.

5 Section 704(b) of the Office of National Drug Control
6 Policy Reauthorization Act of 1998 (21 U.S.C. 1703(b))
7 is amended—

8 (1) by striking paragraph (12);

9 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (13) through
10 (20) as paragraphs (12) through (19), respectively;
11 and

12 (3) in paragraph (13)(A), as so redesignated,
13 by striking “paragraph (13)” and inserting “para-
14 graph (12)”.
